A mutually beneficial long term all-requirement wholesale power agreement with FPL ensures customers receive power from a diverse fuel mix, including solar.

FPL has the largest fleet of solar generation capacity in Florida, and their planned additions are the largest in Florida.

FPL is able to offer utility-scale solar generation and renewable energy solutions when long-term agreements are in place.



LCEC is not in a position to risk entering into additional purchased power agreements.



LCEC encourages individual renewable generation. The LCEC net-metering program provides credit for excess generation.



LCEC offers small environmental awards to fund sustainable projects that benefit members. (based on availability)



LCEC supports FPL sponsored renewable projects by directly interconnecting with their power network.
